

## BOSCH'S AUTODOME EASY II NOMINATED FOR PSI PREMIER AWARD

Bosch Security Systems' AutoDome Easy II has been shortlisted as one of seven finalists in the PSI Premier Awards CCTV Product of the Year category.

The AutoDome Easy II is a sophisticated CCTV dome; an affordable, easy to install PTZ camera system for indoor and outdoor applications incorporating many features more typically associated with higher-end dome camera technologies.

Available in Analogue and IP versions with IVA (Intelligent Video Analytics), the AutoDome Easy II stands out in its field since it is approximately 70% smaller than traditional PTZ cameras and 20% smaller than other compact domes. However despite its size, it provides variable pan and tilt speeds and an autopivot function to ensure optimum camera control and viewing at all zoom levels. The high performance 120x (10x optical/12x digital) zoom autofocus camera incorporates cutting edge digital imaging technology with exceptional sensitivity and resolution.

A single AutoDome Easy II provides the same coverage as four fixed mini domes and comes at a lower price than traditional PTZ dome cameras, which could be one of the reasons why it has been nominated for recognition in the PSI Premier Awards. It is also on the shortlist for the professional installation sector to decide if it deserves to win the title of Product of the Year.

"The compact design of the AutoDome Easy II makes it ideal for scenarios," says Paul Wong, Managing Director of Bosch Security Systems, "especially where discreet surveillance is required but where the customer cannot compromise on performance. Here at Bosch, we are proud that consistent performance is something our customers can rely on us to deliver in all of our products, and equally proud that this has been recognised through the AutoDome Easy II's nomination for a PSI Premier Award."
