

BOSCH LAUNCHES NEW EASY SERIES WITH wLSN TECHNOLOGY

Bosch Security Systems has launched a new version of its Easy Series intruder control panel for residential and small businesses that for the first time incorporates the very latest wireless Security Network Technology (wLSN) to even further ease the installation process and reduce cost, whilst enhancing system reliability and false alarm performance.

The main user interface for Easy Series is a highly stylish icon-based control centre (now capable of being flush-mounted thanks to a bespoke recess kit) that features a very simple text-free, icon-led display. The system is extremely easy to operate, making maximum use of an integrated RFID reader and featuring full voice-based support in the appropriate native language.

Various arming options are available including PIN code, RFID tag, and key fob, as well as having the ability to arm/disarm the system via a mobile phone. Numerous features have been included to reduce false alarms including integrated two-way audio verification, Intelligent Threat Assessment, cross-zoning (ie sequential verification) and graduated annunciation (ie a rising urgency in the control centre volume as each security point is breached). Several integrated transmission options are also available including voice dialler, and digital dialler,

Specifically, wLSN delivers a number of significant installer benefits: being wireless means fast and easy installation and lower installation costs; it has multi-channel operation and is not affected by other RF devices, thus further improving reliability; and it has two-way transmission and auto configuration resulting in predictable, quick and easy programming and set-up.

The new Easy Series also features a signal strength indicator to verify the RF signal prior to mounting, and a battery life of up to five years. The installation process is further helped by the integrated bubble level to ensure a horizontal fit, 45 degree coloured terminal strips, and a covered PCB with detailed description on the cover plate.

Adam Breeze, Strategic Marketing Manager of Bosch Security Systems comments: "The Easy Series radically redefines what is achievable within the intrusion market. It looks different, thinks differently, and 'talks' to the installer – quite literally as it happens – in a way that no other product on the market currently does. Once again it reflects Bosch Security Systems' commitment to setting the trend, rather than following it."

As well as warning of intruders, the new Easy Series can also generate alarms activated by fire and also monitor the condition of freezers, fridges and central heating. A range of associated detection devices is available including wireless PIRs, motion detectors, sirens, smoke detectors, glass break detectors, and door window contacts.

The control panel has eight on-board zones, expandable up to 32 hardwired zones via eight zone modules or 32 wireless, the flexibility of the panel means that this is a truly hybrid control panel. Up to 20 key fobs, tags and codes can be set with the option of three different set and un-set options.. The Grade 2 system is EN50131-1 compliant and EN50131-5-3 approved for radio panels along with the UK standard of PD6662.

Presentations on the new product are currently underway as part of Bosch's Approved Installer Programme, the programme aimed at giving professional installers high-quality products, training and support to enable them to differentiate themselves from others more concerned with short-term gain rather than long-term profitable relationships.
