More than 170,000 festival-goers at Glastonbury have been protected from the threat of crime, including theft, thanks to a CCTV system that relies on Bosch DiBos DVRs.

The Glastonbury Festival of Contemporary Performing Arts is the largest greenfield music and performing arts festival in the world. The festival is best known for its contemporary music, but also features dance, comedy, theatre, circus, cabaret and many other arts. At each of the last three festivals over 700 acts played on over 80 stages to a capacity of 177,500. Crime figures released by Avon and Somerset Police, showed that arrests for the 2008 festival stood at 134, down on 2007 and that 99.7 per cent of revellers did not experience any crime.

Date/time, location, zone and selected camera information are also displayed. Searches can be made either locally or remotely, over a company network or via the internet.
